Landmark Property Sale Announced



The largest ever tract of CBD land is for sale in the heart of Grote Business Precinct.

At nearly 1.8ha, the site (pictured) is occupied by Australia Post's Adelaide Mail Centre and a huge car park. It is expected to fetch above \$40m.

Close to West Terrace, it spans an area between Grote and Gouger Streets, with Blenheim Street as its Eastern boundary.

The land may be sold as a whole or three large allotments. Australia Post workers will move out of

the six-storey building over an 18 month period after the sale is finalised. There is potential for this to become Adelaide's largest ever development site.

"The site's sheer scale, expansive improvements and the myriad of redevelopment and repositioning opportunities provides developers and investors with a once in a lifetime opportunity to secure a gateway site in a precinct that is currently experiencing unprecedented private, institutional and government investment," according to Justin Hazell, of selling agent Colliers International.
